TEAM INFORMATION

| SITES: | MAP Sports Facility, Santiago Canyon College, Chapman University |
| CONDUCT OF PLAYERS: | Any player whose behavior has affected the conduct of the tournament and/or the respectability of the program will be brought before the tournament disciplinary committee. Players and parents will be responsible for any damages incurred during the tournaments. |
| CONDUCT OF PARENTS: | The Head Coach will be responsible for the actions of their parents. Team members whose behavior has affected the conduct of the tournament and /or respectability of the National Junior Basketball program will be brought before the attention of the Head Coach. The official "Bluecard" will be strictly enforced. |
| RULES OF PLAY: | The 2019 Tournament will play under the High School Federation Rule book with the appropriate NJB rules. |
| PRACTICE & GAME BALLS: | Teams must provide their own basketballs during warm-ups. |
| TOURNAMENT FORMAT: | The format will be pool play and bracket championship. |
| MEMBERSHIP: | All players and coaches must be a current NJB Member. |
| COACHES MEETING: | A coach from each team MUST ATTEND the coaches meeting. |
| AWARDS: | Individual awards will be given to 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th place teams. |
| PROTEST: | NJB does not recognize or allow protests during the All-Net Tournament. |
| UNIFORMS: | <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Team jerseys shall be of the same solid color front and back. Shirts shall be tucked inside the game shorts.2. Team shorts shall be alike for all players.3. An undershirt is considered to be part of the shirt and must be a color identical to the shirt. An illegal undershirt may not be worn.4. Each player shall be numbered on the front (at least 4" high) and back (at least 6" high) of the shirt with plain Arabic numbers.5. Sponsor names are permitted so long as placed in a fashion that does not obstruct the uniform number. |
| HOME & VISITOR: | The team listed in the game brackets on the right, will be the Visitor team and shall wear dark uniforms. The team listed on the left, will be the Home team and shall wear white or light colored uniforms. The Home team shall sit at the right of the scorer's table and take the opposite basket for warm-ups and first-half play. |
| OPENING CEREMONY: | All teams must attend the opening ceremony. Players must be in full uniform. |
| BENCH PERSONNEL: | A maximum of three (3) Coaches are allowed on the bench. Coaches must check-in at the gate entrance for tournament wristbands. |

T O U R N A M E N T R U L E S

| RULES OF PLAY: | NJB follows High School Federation rules. |
| LENGTH OF PLAYING TIME: | ALL games will consist of four (4) periods with STOP TIME. 4th, 5th, 6th grades - 7 minute periods 7th, 8th grades - 8 minute periods |
| HALFTIME: | Two minutes in duration. |
| OVERTIME PERIODS: | Each overtime period will be two (2) minutes in duration. |
| TIME-OUTS: | Each team will be allowed three (3) full time-outs in each game. One time-out will be granted to each team for each overtime period. |
| BONUS RULE: | Teams will shoot the one-and-one bonus on the 10th team foul in both halves. |
| EJECTIONS: | If the Head Coach, Assistant Coach, or Spectator is ejected from a game, they will be suspended for the full tournament and will not be allowed in the gymnasium. If this rule is violated, please bring it to the attention of the Site Director. It is the responsibility of the Head Coach to insure the ejected adult does not enter the gymnasium. If this rule is violated, additional sanctions may be applied by the NJB Disciplinary Committee. |
| CONDUCT OF PLAYERS: | The Head Coach is responsible for the actions of their players. Players and parents will be responsible for any damages incurred during the event. <i>The Official Blue Card will be enforced in all games.</i> |
| MERCY RULE: | If team has a 20-point lead during the FOURTH PERIOD, the mercy rule will go into effect. The team will not be allowed to employ a full-court press and may start defense at 1/2 court. The clock will become a running clock at all times, except for time-outs. The clock will become a regulation clock if the point difference reaches 9 points or less. |
| PROTEST: | All player protests MUST be registered BEFORE the start of the game. |
| BALL SIZE: | Boys 4th, 5th, and 6th divisions will use the size 28.5" NJB game ball. Boys 7th and 8th will use the size 29.5" NJB game ball. |

TIE BREAKER:

In a situation where two (2) teams are tied, head to head competition will determine the winner. If more than two (2) teams are tied, a point differential (maximum of 13 points) will be applied. The differentials of all pool games are totaled and the teams are ranked accordingly. The team with the lowest total is eliminated, and will finish in third place. Then the winner from the remaining two (2) teams are determined by Head-to-Head competition. If teams are still tied the final determination will be the total points given up by defense for each team.

SPECTATOR GUIDELINES

The game is for our youngsters. We need your full cooperation and help in providing good sportsmanship and respect. Please follow these guidelines during the tournament.

- 1.) Spectators WILL NOT harass or openly criticize the referees. Verbal abuse will not be tolerated.
- 2.) Spectators WILL NOT harass or berate members of the opposing team or belittle their efforts.
- 3.) Spectators should cheer and encourage their team. Be supportive of their team in victory and likewise in defeat.
- 4.) The official "Blue Card" for sportsmanship will be enforced.
- 5.) **Any adult, including the Head Coach, will not be allowed to attend any games for the duration of the tournament, after an ejection.**

Remember, it is just a game and should be fun for all. Spectators will be required to leave the facility if their behavior does not represent good sportsmanship and respect.
